

## COVID-19 OUTBREAK DISASTER ORDER NO. 1 - APPENDIX A

### RELATING TO THE SUSPENSION OF SECTIONS OF ALASKA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE AND SECTIONS OF ALASKA STATUTES

I, Mike Dunleavy, Governor of the State of Alaska, do hereby authorize this Appendix to COVID-19 Outbreak Health Order No. 1 (“Order”). Pursuant to the Order, the language of each provision set forth below is hereby suspended until **the expiration of the disaster declaration**, unless otherwise individually noted.
